



## Bernard Goss

May 1, 1932 - April 6, 2016

Bernard Goss, 83, went to be with his Lord and Savior on April 6, 2016.

Bernard was born on May 1, 1932 to Homer and Gladys (Hall) Goss in Calhoun, Georgia. Bernard was the oldest brother and was the taskmaster of the household of six children, three boys and three girls. He graduated from high school at 16 and immediately went into the National Guard. He was always mature and ambitious for his age. He stayed with the National Guard until his retirement at 65. He attended North Georgia College, then at 18 he joined the Air Force and went to San Antonio for basic training. After completing Basic Training he began his degree at Trinity College. While at Trinity he met the love of his life and married Nancy Robinson when he was 20 years old and she was 19. Two days after the marriage, he was transferred to Korea, where he served our nation for two years. Upon return, he completed his degree and Nancy started teaching elementary school. Bernard also worked for the Federal Reserves in Dallas for several years before moving to Little Rock, Arkansas to work with the Water Commissioner, preserving water resources along the Mississippi River that benefited our nation's water supply. He received his PhD in Economics after receiving a Fellowship to complete his work at The University of Pennsylvania. Bernard and Nancy were both smart and hardworking individuals who always wanted to give back to their communities. Bernard never missed the opportunity of meeting a stranger and he would boldly share these passions with them. Bernard is survived by one sister: Gloria Bethune of Sarasota, Florida, one brother: Paul Goss of Dalton, Georgia and one brother-in-law, Robert Hill of Woodstock, Georgia. He is preceded in death by his parents, 2 sisters and 1 brother.
